Favourite book?

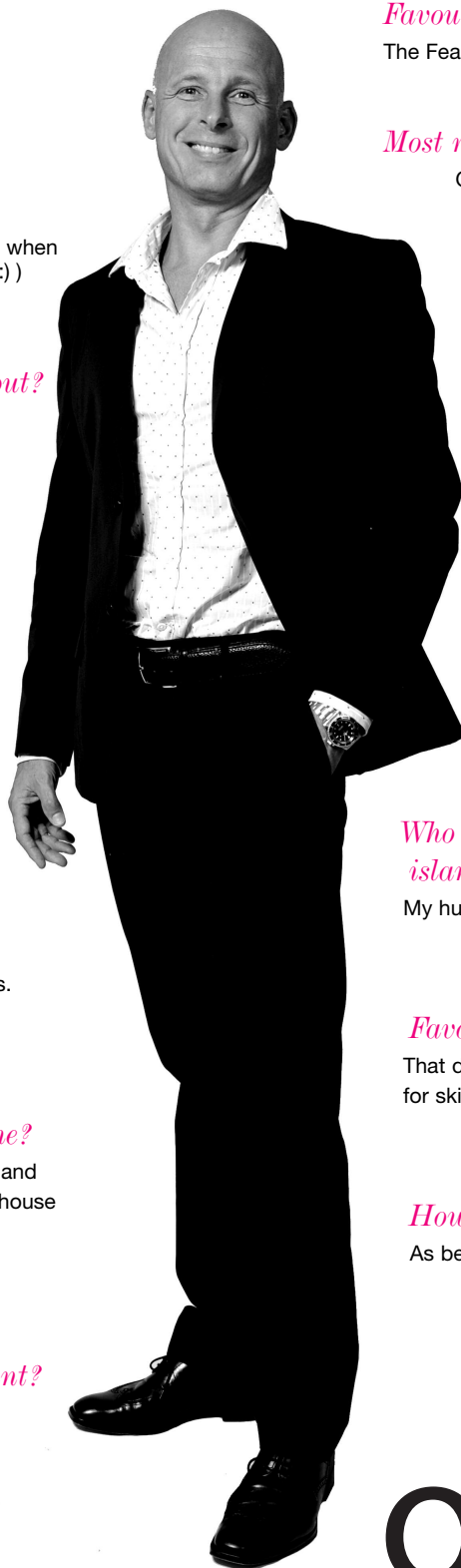
None in particular, but I do enjoy biographies.

Who would you like to be trapped on a desert island with?

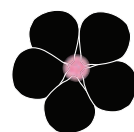
My husband.
