# SLOVENIA

A destination slowly being discovered by the meetings industry, Slovenia has particular appeal during the winter months when the destination takes on a fairytale image with its small alpine towns, deep valleys and high peaks transformed to a snowcapped wonderland. But the experience is much more than just the views and Slovenia has an abundance of outdoor activities to offer; snowshoeing, ice climbing, snow rafting, snow biking, the list is endless

## Day One: Arrival

Arrival at Ljubljana Airport and short transfer towards Bled. Nestled in the Julian Alps, Bled is famous for its tiny, steeped island in the centre of the lake and its medieval cliff-top castle. Marvel at the breathtaking views over lunch then enjoy a tranquil lake ride by traditional pletna boat to Bled Island where a private recital will be performed in the atmospheric setting of a tiny church.

### Evening - Welcome to Slovenia

Slovenian cuisine is heavily influenced by the food of its neighbours and this evening in the homely ambience of a

typical Slovenian restaurant, sample hearty dishes of klobasa sausage from Austria, njoki and rizota from Italy, golaz and palacinke from Hungary to the sounds of a rustic folklore band.

## Day Two: Kravec

Morning transfer to Kravec ski resort for a day of exhilarating activities. Cable cars take you uphill to the very heart of a frosty Alpine world where your day on the snow unfolds, it's a thrilling combination of technical skill and adrenaline rush as you snowshoe, sledge and build igloos.



### Evening - Igloo Village

The temperature may be cold, the welcome is anything but. At the Igloo Village, sample the official drink of Eskimcek and a warming fondue dinner, then the more adventurous of the group can choose to take part in some more activities (snow biking, tobogganing) or party in the Igloo Bar, Igloo Wellness is a welcome retreat for the weary.

### Day Three:

At Bled railway station board a vintage steam train for a one hour journey through idyllic mountain valleys to Slovenia's mediterranean side. Visit the Museum of the First World War.

Continue to the spectacular hillside region of Goriska Brda, renowned for its production of excellent wines. One of Slovenia's expert wine producers will share the secrets of his trade as you sample some delicate creations over lunch. Return to Bled and prepare for this evening's gala dinner.

### Day Four: Ljubljana

Morning transfer to Ljubljana and spend some time exploring its wealth of cultural and architectural treasures including the old city centre, the Plecnik designed Three Bridges, the Baroque Town Hall and Robba's Fountain. After lunch, airport transfers for onward journey home.
