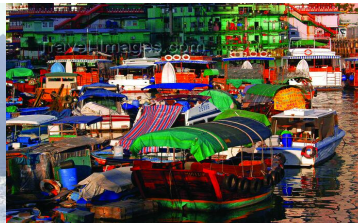


MEETING 3 nights

HONG KONG

Day One:

Morning - Arrival and meeting

Morning - Journey of Enlightenment

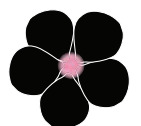
