Day One: Barcelona

At Barcelona International Airport a warm welcome is assured from hostesses dressed in native Catalan dress. There's no time for siesta, choose your scooter for a short refreshing ride to Barcelona heliport where helicopters are waiting to introduce you to Barcelona from the sky. Look out for all the landmarks below - the Olympic Port, Las Ramblas, the Sagrada Familia, Montjuic....

Back on terra firma, continue by bicycle to Barri Gotic the gothic district. Soak up the sights and sounds of the city as you roam, crossing narrow streets, bohemian squares and passing romantic churches at your leisure. After a well deserved beer and Pintxos lunch, there's one more adventure – a GPS guided audio tour taking you by some of the city's architectural highlights right to your hotel.

Evening – Picasso Museum

Day Two: Sitges

Morning – Coastal Cruise

One of the jewels of the Catalan coast, Sitges has been Barcelona's favourite resort since the modernistas flocked here at the turn of the 19th century. In the wine region of Penedes is the famous winery of Codorniu, one of the most prestigious producers of Cava (sparkling wine). Its Art Nouveau cellars provide the stunning setting for a relaxed tasting of three unique cavas.

Evening

Dinner at Barcelona's old harbor where spectacular panoramic views are matched by delicious Catalan specialities.

Day Three:

Morning – Coastal Cruise
